
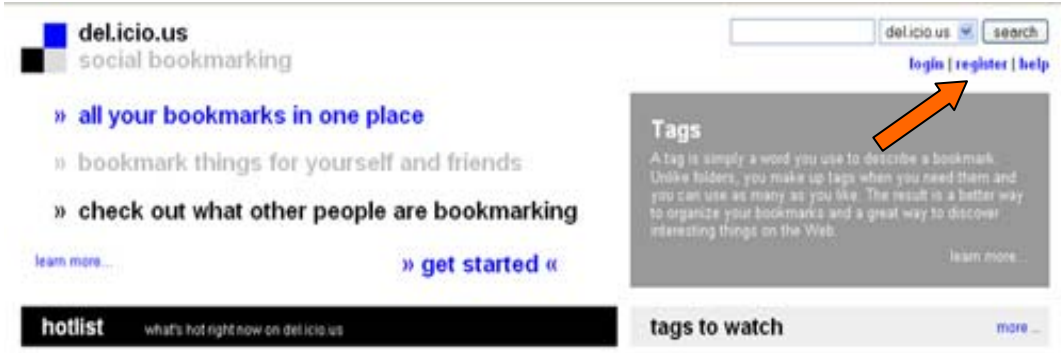


Dear Friend,

I'm adding a social bookmark icon to my website  to encourage everyone to bookmark my web site and all of their other favorites on the internet where they can access them any time from any computer, even after an upgrade or buying a new computer. I would like to help you get started with what we call social bookmarking by teaching you how to bookmark my web site. I recommend that you use a social bookmark web site owned by Yahoo called [del.icio.us](http://del.icio.us). Note that you **don't type www** in front or .com at the end. To make it simple just click on [del.icio.us](http://del.icio.us) right here and it will take you there. It should look something like this.



To get started click on the word register if you have never registered before. A registration screen will appear for you to create an account to keep you bookmarks in.

Be sure to enter the characters in the picture code you see in your registration form in the box below it, then click the "register" button and your account will be created.

To use del.icio.us, you need to install two buttons into your browser. We highly re users install this simple del.icio.us extension:





Now it is prompting you to install the two delicious buttons that will allow you easily add a web site you're interested in to your internet bookmarks. This example was done using Firefox but if you are using Internet Explorer it will be similar. Proceed to install the buttons after which it will have you close and restart your browser so the buttons can be displayed.

Now that you have the buttons, go to [www.massagesaltlake.com](http://www.massagesaltlake.com) and click on the icon that looks like a price tag and has the word "TAG" or says "post to del.icio.us" next to it. By clicking on that icon you can tag this or any web site in your internet favorites. *If you don't see the buttons, then read the information below on finding them.*


Please enter "**Message Salt Lake**" in the description box, this will be beneficial to me. Enter any notes you wish for your own information, such as Ron's Rub Website. In the tags field enter "**Message Salt Lake**" for ease of use later and to help other people find me.

To see your internet favorites simply click on the checkerboard icon and it will take you to del.icio.us and you will login if you aren't already logged in and you book marks will be there waiting for you.

## Finding Your Buttons If They Don't Appear
